NOTICE OF VIOLATION - 75 Pa.C.S. §3369 Automated Work Zone Speed Enforcement

You have been identified as the registered owner of a vehicle that exceeded the posted speed limit by at least 11 MPH in an active work zone. An automated speed enforcement system detected and recorded the violation at the place, date, and time shown on the Notice of Violation. You must respond by the Due Date on the Notice of Violation to request a hearing. If you do not wish to contest this violation, a hearing is not required and <u>no action</u> is necessary at this time.

NOTE: While no payment is due at this time, subsequent violations will result in monetary fines. No points will be assessed against your driver record for this Notice of Violation.

Request a Hearing to Contest Liability

You may contest liability by requesting a hearing by the Due Date of this Notice of Violation. Defenses to liability are:

- The vehicle was reported to a police department as stolen prior to the time the violation occurred and was not recovered prior to that time.
- The person receiving the Notice of Violation was not the owner of the vehicle at the time of the offense.
- The device used to determine speed was not in compliance with 75 Pa.C.S. §3368 (relating to speed timing devices) with respect to testing for accuracy, certification or calibration.

You may request a hearing by either (1) submitting a request through the program website, or (2) submitting the Hearing Request Form on the reverse side of this page.

- The Hearing Request Form may be submitted online through the program website at workzonecameras.penndot.gov. Go to the Violations tab and click on View Your Violation. Log in by entering the Violation Number, License Plate Number, and PIN Number for the Notice of Violation. Click on the Contest Your Violation button and complete the form.
- The Hearing Request Form may be submitted by mail (see coupon for instructions) or in person at the AWZSE Customer Service Center (CSC) located at 740 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106. The Service Center is open weekdays from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM, and the last Saturday of each month from 8:30 AM to 12:00 PM (excluding holidays). Note: If you are requesting hearing at the walk-in location, the hearing will not occur at the time of the request. You will receive by mail a written confirmation of the date, time and location of your in-person hearing.

You may choose a written determination by a hearing officer or an in-person hearing before a hearing officer based on the documents provided.

- If you request an in-person hearing, you will receive written confirmation by mail of the date, time and the location of the scheduled hearing. You may request a preferred hearing location. Hearing offices are located in Erie, Pittsburgh, Harrisburg, Philadelphia, and Scranton metropolitan areas.
- If you request a written determination without a hearing, the hearing officer will make a decision based on documents only. You will receive instructions by mail on how to submit your supporting documentation. Instructions for submitting supporting documentation are also available on the program website.

FAILURE TO REQUEST A HEARING BY THE DUE DATE WAIVES YOUR RIGHT TO A HEARING
